PARTICIPATION

National Affiliation:

The Baltic Judo Championship is open to members of the Latvian Judo Federation, the Estonian Judo Association, and the Lithuanian Judo Federation. Participants must have the same national affiliation as the country registering them.

AGE GROUPS

- U-18 Age Group: Born between 2008 and 2010.
- U-21 Age Group: Born between 2005 and 2010.

REGISTRATION

Registration for the competition will take place through the LDF electronic system (https://sportists.info/judo/login.php) until <u>Thursday, January 23, at 23:00.</u> No registrations will be accepted after the deadline.

PARTICIPATION FEE

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Delegation Composition:

Each club may register an unlimited number of athletes (both men and women) in each weight category.

• Match Duration: 4 minutes with no limit for Golden Score.

Weight Categories

U-18

- Women: -40, -44, -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, +70 kg
- Men: -50, -55, -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, +90 kg

U-21

- Women: -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, -78, +78 kg
- Men: -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, -100, +100 kg

WEIGH-IN

Official weigh-ins will take place the day before (January 24) for U-18 and U-21 and on competition days (see the program).

- U-18 athletes must wear at least underwear for weigh-ins. Boys must have underwear, and girls must have underwear and a T-shirt.
- A weight allowance of 200g is permitted.
- Athletes must present their participation form and either a passport or an ID card showing nationality and birthdate.

DRAW

The draw time and location are specified in the program.

AWARDS

- 1st place: Gold medal and diploma
- 2nd place: Silver medal and diploma
- 3rd place: Bronze medal and diploma

JUDOGI CHECK

White and blue judogis (IJF-approved) are mandatory. Judogis must comply with Sokuteiki criteria.

REFEREEING

Referee Registration:

Each federation must nominate three referees. The host federation must ensure there are enough referees for the competition. Referees must hold at least the highest national license and have a minimum of two years of experience.

Referee Meeting:

A referee meeting will be held one hour before the start of the competition on the first day. Attendance is mandatory.

Refereeing Rules:

The competition will be conducted under IJF and EJU rules and the Sports Code.

COACHES

Coaches must strictly adhere to the IJF Sports and Organizational Rules Appendix 4.

- Coaches may not give instructions to athletes during the fight.
- Instructions are allowed only during breaks (after "matte").
- Coaches must remain silent during fights.
- Violations may lead to removal from the competition venue or further sanctions.

AWARD CEREMONY

All medalists must attend the award ceremony in person. Athletes who fail to attend without justification will forfeit their medal. Only equipment related to the sport may be displayed on the podium; political, religious, personal, or commercial symbols are strictly prohibited.
